CMS has been a tremendous blessing for our family in more ways than we could have ever imagined. Initially when we decided send our youngest to CMS we were filled with trepidation, especially since we had sent our older two daughters to a nearby program that was incredibly well run and quite frankly, CMS is much further away from our house. However, we are so glad we decided to send our youngest daughter Brielle to CMS and looking back, it was probably the best decision we could have made for her.

The first thing that stands out about CMS is the teaching staff. We could tell that the staff all operate with a sense of calling in their lives, that this isn't just a job for them but that it's a calling for them to make a positive impact in the lives of the children they teach and care for, all for the glory of God. That sense of calling permeates through their attitude, demeanor, and

Even when our daughter has caused some issues (I'm certain she causes many issues everyday she's is 2 years old:), the staff are so encouraging and positive in the way they approach the issue that it encourages us to be better parents ourselves.

At times when we are picking up our kids, we've sometimes had a long and hard day ourselves but the enthusiastic, joyful, positive energy that 전도사님 and the staff exude gives us joy and positive energy to face the rest of the day ourselves. I don't think there is another Montessori school in all of south Texas where merely picking up their children, the parents are filled with joy for the rest of the day - this simply doesn't happen anywhere else.

Lastly, the most meaningful part of our experience at CMS is the love that the teachers lavish on our daughter Brielle. We really feel that our daughter is loved and cherished. Many times we have felt that the teachers and staff of CMS really love our daughter like family. Looking back, my wife and I have had countless discussions over dinner that our daughter's teacher really loves and deeply cherishes and cares for Brielle. This type of love and genuine care for our daughter is palpable every time we drop her off, every time we pick her up and every time we interact with the staff at CMS. We are deeply moved, even now, as we just write about the love that Brielle has received from CMS teachers and staff over the years.
